„AI-deliberative acts: truth, trust & hope in a virtual multilingual space“

Interactive workshop with students & teachers, representatives from the 7 ERASMUS+ project Le_MOON partner countries (Austria, Czech Republic, France, Iceland Lithuania, Poland, Turkey) & guest participants from the ADEPS organization & Noahs Ark Academy Maragoli, Kenya

Aim: annual event, with preparatory activity for the development of the AI-tools & guidelines for responsible use and creating an art-manifesto format for the EU-AI act policy recommendations by youth with deliberative approach; exchanging experiences, ideas, concerns, networking, connecting, celebrating language diversity in a virtual space

Motto: following the motto of the EU *United in Diversity*, while situating diversity in a virtual multilingual space and exploring relational cultures & ethics by use of the AI tools for communication with deliberative approach

Insights:

Introductory session (3 min)

Student presentations to the topic “AI- Truth, Trust & hope” (30 sec. each), posters with collected key terms on: AI-tools experiences in use by students and teachers (what tools, for what purposes), criteria for trustful use and the content approval, responsible use (recommended platforms, & ethical guide provided by teachers, approx. daily time spent with AI tools for learning & communication); critical observations (data protection, generated content,...) and envisioned optimization of the AI for learning and communication (ideas shared by students & teachers) shared in the chat space, then collected on MIRO platform:
